

Design Technology

From the Early Years the Design and Technology curriculum is practical encouraging pupils to use their creativity to design and make products that solve real problems within a variety of contexts. Pupils learn through the evaluation of past and present design and develop a critical understanding of its impact on daily life and the wider world.

Each class takes part on one Art and Design Technology day each half term where the whole day is linked to these subjects.

Whilst in key stage 1 the children will complete at least 2 cooking projects each half term and the Key stage 2 children will complete at least 1. We follow the focus on food recipes. The focus on food recipes introduce the children to a whole range of new experiences which develop life long skills that will lead to a healthier adult life. The children will learn about where their food comes from, how its grown and the principles of a healthy diet.
