

History



In History, children at our school have the opportunity to investigate and interpret the past, understand chronology, develop an understanding of Britain's past, how it has influenced and been influenced by the wider world.

We also focus on the history of our local area including learning about The Piece Hall, The Gibbet and the Bombing of Halifax in 1940. We consider the lives of significant people in the past from a variety of cultures. We also study Ancient Civilisations including Greece, Egypt and Baghdad.

Children are taught to understand the methods of historical enquiry including investigating artefacts, considering various sources of evidence and asking and answering questions.

Developing our pupils' curiosity and love of history is not just classroom based, we invite visitors into school both in person and virtually, visit significant places, sites and explore our local area.
