COVID 19 "Catch-up" Funding Spending Strategy 2020-2021

Funding

The school will receive £80/pupil which will be paid in instalments.

Autumn Term 2020

Based on 149 pupils

£80/pupil = £11,920

Autumn payment = £2,980

Spending Strategy

The school undertook baseline assessments in a variety of forms in order to establish the priority areas of provision arising out of school closing to the majority of pupils during the Spring and Summer terms. After initial analysis of all year groups, it was deemed necessary to concentrate the additional funding in the areas outlined below.

Phonics Interventions Year 1 and 2

Analysis of baseline assessments has revealed lower achievement in phonics and reading in KS1. Extra phonics and reading sessions will be provided for selected children in the afternoons and after school to boost reading achievement. The interventions will be delivered by teaching assistants and a teacher. Achievement will be evidenced in school's normal assessment cycles and EDUKEY.

This will be partly funded by Catch-up funding.

Cost £530

Impact

Reading in Year 5

Baseline assessments have revealed that a high proportion of children in Year 5 have fallen further behind than would normally be expected in reading. Following the success of the Reading Plus programme introduced last year in Year 6, we have purchased this programme for Year 5 pupils. This on-line programme can be accessed by pupils at home and therefore learning will continue during lockdown/"bubble" closures. Progress in reading will be monitored through the Reading Plus programme and school's tracking system.

This will be partly funded by Catch-up funding.

Cost £1200

Impact

Writing Intervention in Year 6

Analysis of baseline assessments have revealed that some Year 6 pupils have fallen behind in writing. Structured after school interventions are delivered to selected pupils. Progress will be monitored on EDUKEY and the school tracking system.

This will be partly funded by Catch-up funding.

Cost £500

Impact

Reading, writing and maths interventions in Year 3 and Year 4

A group of children in LKS2 have fallen behind in reading, writing and mathematics. These children have been targeted for additional daily support in all 3 subjects. Progress will be monitored on the school's tracking system and EDUKEY.

Cost £750

Impact
